She will step down from her current post as a Board Director with the foundation to assume her new role, which begins on July 11, 2022.

Piergallini has 20 years of experience in fundraising, development, and special events for nonprofits. Most recently serving as the Director of Development for the Center for Loss and Bereavement in Skippack, she led all aspects of development, including all fundraising events, individual giving, major donors, corporate sponsorships, and grant funding. Under her leadership, she has

helped various organizations raise over a million dollars at special events, grew donor support by more than 25 percent, and increased grant funding by 50 percent.

Piergallini's appointment comes as the foundation implements a plan to build upon existing relationships with major donors, cultivates new partnerships with individual donors, and prepares for its 3rd annual APEX Awards. She is eager to lean on her experience and background to execute the mission of the foundation. "As a fundraising professional and a parent of two children in the Methacton School District, it gives me great pleasure to be able to support the Methacton School District through the efforts of the Methacton Education Foundation to fund innovative educational programs and initiatives to enrich the student experience," said Piergallini, who will report to the Board of Directors.

Piergallini earned a bachelor's degree in marketing from Saint Joseph's University and a master's in broadcasting, telecommunications, and mass media from Temple University's School of Communications.
